Work Permit & B-1 Work Visa for up to 45 days (SEA): Process Overview

- □ Diploma/Training certificate/support letter (if not originally in English, certificates will have to be translated into Hebrew and notarized by an Israeli notary)
- □ Copy of passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from the end of the assignment)
- ☐ Forms completed and signed
- ☐ Two (2) passport-size photos

The SEA visa is applicable only for nationals under waiver program.

Working in Israel without a valid B-1 work visa is a criminal offence of both the employee and employer. Please carry your passport with you in Israel at all times, including when at work site. This obligation is a legal requirement.
