Since the draft proposal of the Global Corporate Relocation Treaty was featured in the [previous edition](#) of the Global Migration Digest, updates are in order just in time for the New Year!

On behalf of the International Bar Association (IBA) GEI sub-committee, Graeme Kirk and Tsvi Kan-Tor met with representatives from the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in Paris on November 6th to present the draft proposal of the GCRT. As review of the treaty is currently underway at the OECD, a growing interest by professionals in the industry all over the world has kept the treaty's spirits high during the holiday season.

Karl Waheed, GCRT "Country Ambassador" from France showed his support by presenting the proposed treaty to HR managers responsible for global mobility from 16 different leading companies at a gathering in Paris on December 3rd. Karl's efforts and enthusiasm in this venture have been greatly appreciated.

In other GCRT news, a survey is currently being drafted to identify the key issues and obstacles faced in expert mobility and corporate relocation. Approximately 20-30 minutes in length, the survey will be distributed in each country by the local GCRT
